Deadline for submission: **March 31st, 2020**

Two scholarships will be awarded in May to be used to defray tuition and expenses for the Fall 2020 Semester, all scholarship funds will be made out directly to the Educational Institution.

Amount of Scholarship: **\$2,500**

NeBAA Recommends and/or Requires each applicant:

1. Be enrolled in, or planning to attend, a college in Nebraska or Iowa. (Required)
2. Maintain a Commendable GPA and provide a current transcript. (Required)
3. Have a desire to pursue a career in Business or Corporate Aviation. (Required)
4. Provide at least one letter of recommendation from; (Required)
 - a faculty member of the college, or
 - an employer, or
 - an aviation professional reference.
5. Provide a typed one page essay describing why you are interested in a Business and Corporate Aviation career. (Required)
6. Become a Student Member of NeBAA. (Recommended)
7. Provide a current resume including contact phone and email (required)

Scholarship winners will be notified in writing as well as recognized at the NeBAA May, 2020 Luncheon Event, Time & location TBD. Attendance at the event is encouraged though not required.
